As a Teacher of Singing, the ideal candidate will provide skilled instrumental tuition in singing, fostering a love of music across a range of styles. The ideal candidate will be able to motivate and inspire children, monitor progress, and offer tailored support, including examination preparation. They will also contribute to the extra-curricular life of the school, including concert rehearsals and performances.

Key responsibilities:

Singing Teaching

- To assess potential pupils suitability for the instrument in consultation with the Director of Music
- To teach individual pupils, and small groups where appropriate, providing a well-planned and structured framework to support musical learning
- To keep accurate records of lessons, progress and achievement and ensure effective communication with parents
- To prepare pupils, when and where appropriate, for the requirements of the ABRSM or other approved practical examinations ensuring that all aspects are well prepared
- To teach pupils a range of repertoire including Classical, Folk, Jazz, Latin, Pop and Rock music.
- To train pupils in aural, sight-reading and general musicianship skills
- To promote the instrument through assemblies, concerts, masterclasses or other suitable initiatives





Classroom Teaching

- To deliver engaging curriculum music lessons across the Prep School (ages 7-13)
- To support whole-school singing and termly concerts and productions
- To support he Director of Music with reports, parents evenings and other academic enrichment activities.

- To maintain and foster positive links with parents / families through formal and informal parents' meetings and occasional lesson visits
